The Stash the Trash program continues its nineteenth year! This program works to get students out of the classroom and into their communities by participating in a one day litter pickup on or near their schoolgrounds. All schools in the City of Pittsburgh, including private, public, parochial or charter can participate. Please consider joining other schools in the City on Friday October 21st 2011 and participate in the Fall Stash the Trash Day!

This letter serves as a reminder that Stash the Trash Day is on the horizon and the time to register your school is now! Trash and recycling bags and gloves will be provided on a first come, first served basis. Most schools use their own dumpsters to dispose of the trash and schools may enlist the help of the City's Department of Public Works for special recycling pick up.



To register please complete the Stash the Trash registration form by Friday October 7, 2011. Schools are encouraged to participate on a different day if they are not able to on the 21st! Just mark your date on the form!
